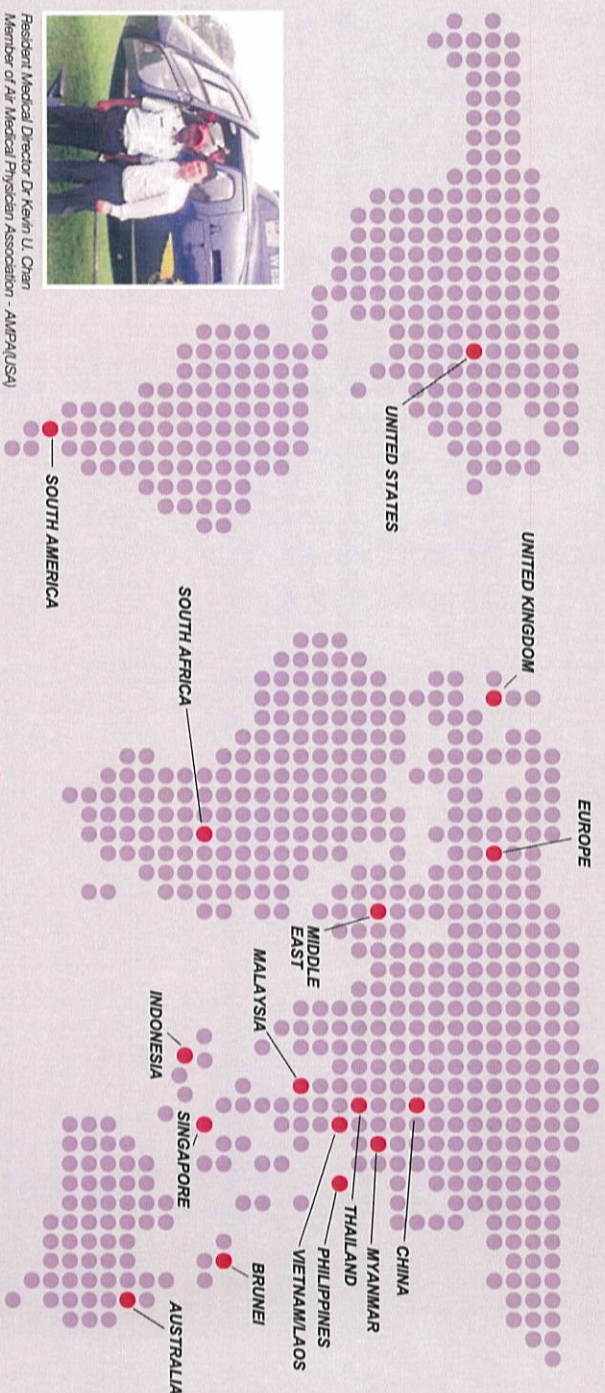
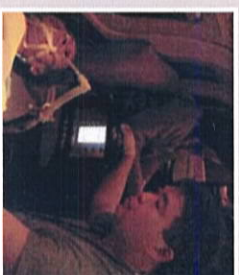
- Onsite Emergency Response assessment of the worksite – Barge, FPSO, Vessel, Oil Rig, etc.
- A description of the response organization (structure, roles, responsibilities, decision makers)
- Policies defining measures for limiting or stopping events in question and conditions for termination of action.
- Easy to follow response (such as procedures for details of response equipment and location, procedures, training requirements, duties, etc)
- Descriptions and procedures for alarm and communications systems
- Evacuation Procedures – Helicopter Casualty Extraction, Air Ambulance Transfers
- List of: On-site first Aid supplies and available back up medical support, MEDEVAC facilities and other emergency facilities such as emergency re-fueling sites. List to include survival equipment and gear, alternate accommodation facilities, and emergency power sources, diving & maritime emergency medical supplies (DMAC 15 etc)
